

## **Weapons Policy**

While a state law in Wisconsin allows residents who have a permit to carry concealed weapons, it is Good Shepherd Services policy that weapons of any kind are not permitted in any Good Shepherd Services buildings or vehicles.

Signs have been posted at the entrances of Good Shepherd Services buildings advising residents, clients, tenants, visitors and staff of the policy. By law, this allows Good Shepherd Services to prevent anyone from bringing a weapon (such as guns, Tasers, billy clubs, knives, brass knuckles, etc.) into a Good Shepherd Services building.

If weapons are seen or suspected, the person will be advised of Good Shepherd Services policy and be required to properly secure the weapon in their personal vehicle. Any concerns regarding weapons should be brought to the Human Resources Representative, Charge Nurse, or Program Director.

Law enforcement will be contacted for non-compliance with this policy. Non-compliant employees, tenants, vendors or visitors, etc, will be prosecuted to the full extent allowed by law.
